#### Description

During FMS 5 setup, a Node will be created. To create this Node name FMS setup will retrieve the computer name to name this Node.

It is strongly advised to rename this Node name to a name which will be more representative of the facility, for example "Building\_1" or "Production\_Line1"...

#### Requirements

- FMS 5.0.7 or later must be installed.
- The Guard Service should be stopped.
- FMS Client is not running.

## Assumptions

- Computer name is: AC155
  FMS5 folder installation is: C:\FMS5
- Node Name after FMS5 installation:
- New Node Name: BUILDING\_1



## **How to Proceed**

- 1. Open the folder **C:\FMS5\Node** in Windows<sup>®</sup> Internet Explorer<sup>®</sup> browser.
- 2. Rename the file "AC155.xml" to "BUILDING\_1.xml".
- 3. Open the renamed file "**BUILDING\_1.xml**" (in WordPad or Notepad) and change the text in the first line from **<AC155>** to **<BUILDING\_1>**.
- 4. Change the text in the last line from </AC155> to </BUILDING\_1> as shown below:

- 5. Search the file and change any other occurrences of "AC155" to "BUILDING\_1".
- 6. Save the changes and close file.
- 7. Open the folder **C:\FMS5\Maps** in Windows<sup>®</sup> Internet Explorer<sup>®</sup> browser.
- 8. Rename the file "FMS\_DEMO.xml" to "BUILDING\_1.xml" and "FMS\_DEMO.jpg" to "BUILDING\_1.jpg".

9. Open the renamed file **BUILDING\_1.xml** (in WordPad or Notepad) and search the file and change the occurrence of "**AC155**" to "**BUILDING\_1**" as shown below:

- 10. Open the folder C:\FMS5\Users in Windows® Internet Explorer® browser.
- 11. Rename the folder "AC155\$" to "BUILDING\_1". This ensures configured reports remain accessible.
- 12. Open the file "C:\FMS5\Bin\Guard.ini" (in WordPad or Notepad) and change the line

```
C:\FMS5\bin\Monitor

to

C:\FMS5\bin\Monitor -node=BUILDING_1
```

- 13. Save your changes and close the file.
- 14. Start the Guard Service.
- 15. Start FMS Client.
- 16. The new name "**BUILDING\_1**" now defines the Node as shown below:
